**Distribution:** This species is probably native to America, now naturalised in the tropics of the world. Within India, it is found throughout the warmer parts of India.




### Common Uses

The whole plant of Bhumyamalaki is used to treat jaundice, chronic dysentery, dyspepsia, cough, indigestion, diabetes, urinary tract diseases, skin diseases, ulcer, sores and swelling. Jaundice: Paste of bhumyamalaki made with buttermilk is recommended in jaundice. (10-20 gms) (VD.10.4). Leucorrhoea / Pradara: Root of bhumyamalaki taken with rice-water (10-20 gms) days checks bleeding (YT.74.9)
