

Plant Species

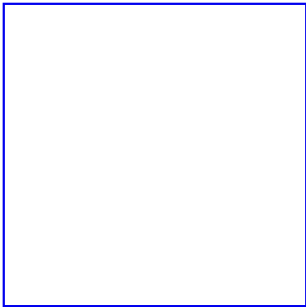
Accepted Name: *Acalypha indica* L.
Family: EUPHORBIACEAE
Used in: Ayurveda, Siddha, Folk, Homeopathy
Habit: Herb
Distribution: This species is globally distributed from Tropical Africa to Malesia. Within India, it occurs throughout the plains, reaching upto an altitude of 210 m. in Orissa and also found in the Western Ghats. It is a weed in gardens, in waste places and along the roadsides.
