Habit: Climber

Distribution: Globally the species is distributed in India, Sri Lanka and Bangladesh. Within India it is distributed in Arunachal Pradesh and in South India. This species is globally distributed in India, Sri Lanka and Bangladesh. Within India, it is found throughout tropical India, ascending to an altitude of 300m. It is often cultivated.



Common Uses

The stem, root and leaf of Guduchi is used in the form of juice and decoction to treat fever, irregular fever, chronic fever, jaundice, thirst, vomiting, arthritis, skin diseases, cough, as rejuvenative for purifying breast-milk, eye diseases.


Irregular fever One should take decoction of guduchi, nimba (azadirachta indica) and amalaki (Phyllanthus emblica) mixed with honey (40-60 ml) (SS.U.39.213)

Amlapitta (Acid gastritis) Decoction of guduchi, nimba (azadirachta indica) and patola (Trichosanthes dioica) leaves mixed with honey alleviates varied forms of severe acid gastritis / amlapitta (BP.Ci.10.16) Arthritis / Vatarkta For arthritis, milk cooked with guduchi decoction (AH.Ci.22.7) is recommended (40-60 ml) Decoction prepared with 30gm of guduchi, suthi (zingiber officinale) and dhanyaka (Coriandrum sativum) alleviates arthritis and skin diseases / 40-60 ml(VM.23.4;BP.Ci.29.42)
