Accepted Name: *Coptis teeta* WALL.
Family: RANUNCULACEAE
Used in: Ayurveda, Siddha, Unani
Habit: Herb
Threat: VU/NE
Distribution: This species is endemic to India recorded only in the Himalayan region across Darjeeling in the West Bengal, Sikkim and Arunachal Pradesh in an altitude range of 2500-3000 m. It has been recorded in Lohit district, Dibang Valley district, Siang and upper Subansiri districts of Arunachal Pradesh.
