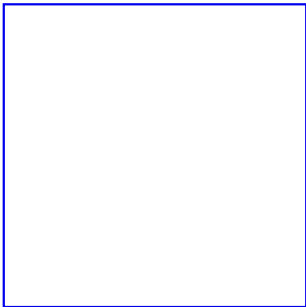

In Maharashtra, it has been recorded in Borivilli and Kanheri caves. In Gujarat, it has been recorded in Ahwa in Dangs.**Common Uses**

The root of Musali is used in the form of powder to treat freckles, deafness and as aphrodisiac. Refer Musali, Curculigo orchioides
