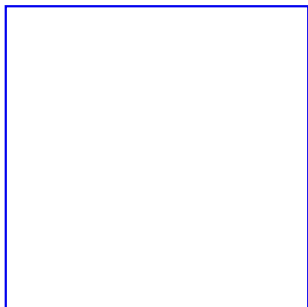
Distribution: This species is globally distributed in Afghanistan, India and Japan. Within India, it is found throughout the hilly regions of India, ascending to an altitude of 3600 m. in the western Himalayas and between an altitude range of 1500-2400 m. in Sikkim and Khasi hills; it is also found in Mount Abu in Rajasthan, and in the western ghats from Konkan southwards to Kerala.
