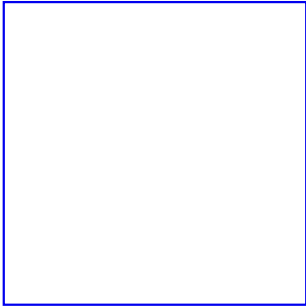


Plant Species**Accepted Name:** *Zizyphus mauritiana* LAM.**Family:** RHAMNACEAE**Synonyms:**

Used in: Ayurveda, Siddha, Unani, Folk, Sowa Rigpa**Habit:** Tree

Distribution: This is a species of the tropics. In India it is found to be distributed in Jammu and Kashmir, Himalayas, Uttar Pradesh, Sikkim, Meghalaya, Arunachal Pradesh, Maharashtra and in the Deccan Peninsula. This species is globally distributed in the Paleotropics. Within India, it is found throughout the hotter parts upto an altitude of 1800 m. in the Himalayas. It is wild or naturalised and often cultivated in gardens.
