

Within India, it is found in the Himalayas from Nepal eastwards, in North-eastern India, Deccan Peninsula and the Andaman Islands, ascending to an altitude of 1500 m.

**Common Uses**

The stamens and flowers of Nagakesara is used in the form of powder to treat diarrhoea with blood, hiccup, leucorrhoea for conception and bleeding piles.
