

DURVA (GRASS)



Scientific name- *Cynodon dactylon*

Family- Poaceae (Grass family)

Description

Habitat: Durva is a warm-season grass that thrives in tropical and subtropical regions. It is often found in open fields, along roadsides, and in gardens.

Morphological Features:

Appearance: Durva is a perennial, creeping grass with slender stems that can grow up to 30-40 cm in height.

Leaves: The leaves are linear, flat, and about 2-8 cm long. They are green to greyish-green in color.

Roots: The plant has a robust and fibrous root system.

Properties:

Rasa (Taste): Durva is said to have astringent and sweet tastes.

Guna (Quality): It is light, dry, and cold in nature.

Virya (Potency): Durva is considered cooling in potency.

Vipaka (Post-digestive effect): It has a sweet post-digestive effect (Madhura Vipaka).

7- Joint Health: Durva's anti-inflammatory properties can be useful in

conditions and menstrual problems.
