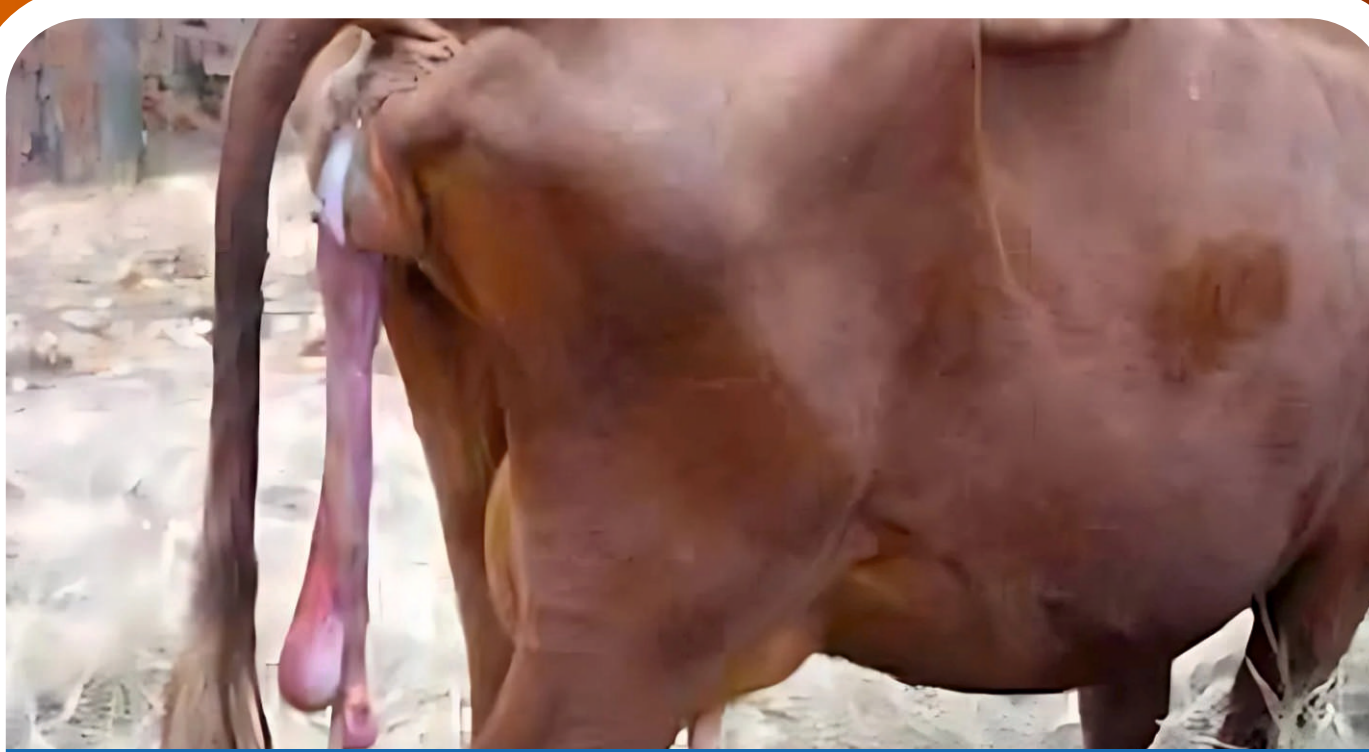


Is your animal showing Brucellosis symptoms? **ACT NOW!**

Brucellosis can spread to humans!

Transmission routes



In contact with
uterine discharges



Drinking of
raw milk

Symptoms in Humans



Symptoms like undulant fever, joint/muscle pain,
orchitis, fatigue, night sweats etc.



Timely treatment is crucial for humans!

- ❖ Specific antibiotics can cure if diagnosed early
- ❖ See doctor immediately if exposed or symptomatic

Prevention is the ONLY solution!

For animals

- Vaccinate female calves between 6-8 months of age
- Isolate/test suspected animals
- Carry out proper disinfection of infected premises



For humans

- Only consume pasteurized or boiled milk
- Do not handle afterbirth with bare hands
